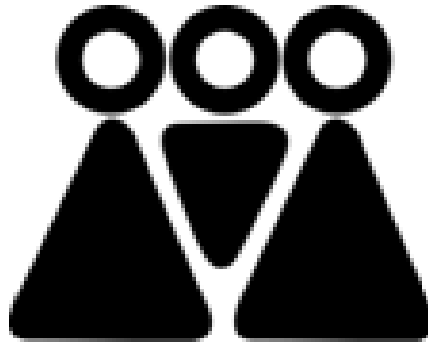

The Mission of the Foundation

Established in 1983 and amended in August 1999, the mission of the Minnesota Women of Today Foundation is to support the programs of the Minnesota Women of Today by developing financial and non-financial resources and to provide appropriate oversight and distribution of funds raised. The Minnesota Women of Today is a volunteer organization open to individuals over the age of 18, which focuses on community development, leadership training and personal enrichment. As of April 30, 2023, there are approximately 921 members in 47 communities across the state of Minnesota. The Minnesota Women of Today is part of a national network of volunteers through its membership in the United States Women of Today.

Chairman's Letter

The MN Women of Today Foundation completed its 39th year and raised \$9,000 in donations to support the mission of the Foundation which is to support the chapters, members and programs of the MN Women of Today. The 2022 Give to the Max Day event raised \$710 in this fourteenth annual event. At each MNWT Convention we staffed a table to promote the Foundation spreading the word on how the Foundation can help Women of Today members and their chapters.



During the 2022- 2023 fiscal year, the Foundation awarded two scholarships totaling \$1,000 to two individuals, one honorarium to a charity in the name of the award recipient, two chapters were awarded a chapter grant for \$1,000, awarded over \$530 toward membership incentives, and donated \$2,962 to the Minnesota Women of Today leadership training. These awards helped defray costs for training, convention speakers, membership rebates, purchasing Chapter Service Center equipment, moving the chapter service center and to support programming projects. In addition, local chapters received corporate and local donations totaling over \$49,000 for their local projects. This would not be possible without the continued support of our members including the 47 members who renewed their Sustaining Membership.

On behalf of the Board of Directors, we thank you for your continued support and look forward to strengthening our partnership and the Minnesota Women of Today organization.

Programs of the Foundation

Sustaining Members

- Contributors who donate a minimum of \$25 to the overall programs of the Foundation.
- Forty Seven (47) individuals/chapters contributed \$1,884 as sustaining members this year.

Chapter Grants Program

- Donations are utilized to give grants to Minnesota Women of Today chapters wanting to implement a project that would not be possible without financial aid.
- Grant applicants must donate at least \$25 to the Foundation within the previous 24 months of the date of their application to be eligible to apply.
- Two Grants were awarded during the 2022-23 year.
- The fundraiser at the 2023 Winter State meeting raised \$1,506.
- Over \$42,971 in chapter grants has been awarded to chapters since 1987.



Brainerd Lakes Area was awarded a chapter grant for \$300 in support of their Happy Hour with a Purpose Event and Fridley a chapter grant for \$700 in support of their Bike Safety Helmet event.

Cheryl L. Anderson Memorial Scholarship

- Donations are accepted throughout the year from individuals, chapters and businesses for this scholarship, which is awarded at the Fall State meeting. Recipients must be members of the Minnesota Women of Today for at least three years, be seeking higher education and be in need of financial assistance.
- Total scholarship funds awarded to date total \$24,000.
- No scholarships were awarded this year.
- The Silent Art Auction fundraiser at the 2023 Winter State meeting raised \$348.

Straight River Scholarship

The Straight River Women of Today chapter established a scholarship through the Foundation for members who are furthering their education in an area or training/workshop to help those who are physically or mentally challenged.

- No scholarships were awarded this year.
- Total scholarships awarded to date total \$7,115.

Outstanding Young Adult Scholarship

- Contributions are accepted throughout the year from individuals, chapters and businesses to provide scholarships for a maximum of five Outstanding Young Adults selected by the Minnesota Women of Today for their volunteer contributions to their communities. They are honored at the Winter State meeting.
- Two \$500 scholarships were awarded to Outstanding Young Adult recipients this year.

Lois M. Christensen Women Who Impact Award

- Contributions are accepted throughout the year from individuals, chapter and businesses to provide an honorarium to Women Who Impact Award Recipients toward a charity of their choice. Up to three Recipients are honored each year in three categories; Youth Outreach, Non-Profit and Women's Advocacy.
- There was one Women Who Impact recipient this year.

Person With Determination Award

- Contributions are accepted throughout the year from individuals, chapter and businesses to provide an honorarium to Person with Determination Award Recipients toward a charity of their choice. This is a new Award, replacing the Person with Developmental Challenges Award, first recognized at Winter State 2021.
- There was no Person with Determination recipient this year.

Corporate Solicitations and Grant Seeking

- Throughout the year, funds are sought from businesses and foundations to fund training programs and supplement donations to other programs of the Minnesota Women of Today. Over \$18,000 has been secured for the MNWT and local chapters through miscellaneous grants and donations.
- The following grants were secured on behalf of the Minnesota Women of Today Foundation during this fiscal year:

Financial Assistance for New/Reactivated Chapters

- Grants and loans are available to new or reactivated chapters under this program.
- The new chapter grants program was initiated in 1993 for newly extended chapters. Donations totaling over \$7,950 have been awarded to 45 chapters in the years 1993-2023.

Give to the Max Day

- Held in November of each year this one day of giving across the county is promoted by the Foundation as a way to increase awareness of the Foundation and to raise funds for our programs.
- This year's Give to the Max Day in November 2022 raised \$710 in donations.

Fall State Project Fair

- The Foundation has a booth at the annual project fair held at the Fall State Convention of the Minnesota Women of Today.
- The purpose is to heighten awareness among Women of Today members of the programs of the Foundation and how they can benefit members and their chapters.
- Donations are solicited for the endowment fund, sustaining membership and various programs of the Foundation.
