Here we are in the second trimester. Fall around the corner...and chapters busy as can be.

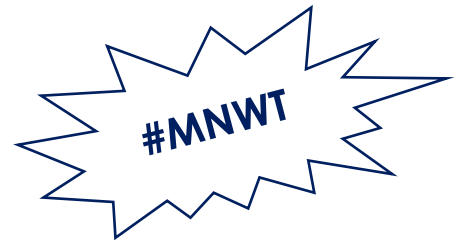
The Future Directions committee has been busy as well. Committee task Forces have been meeting and recommendations will be presented at our next meeting in November.
